In October of 2008 C.D. Products Inc. applied two coats of EUCLID DIAMOND HARD followed by a top coat of their FLORIDYNE TOP BLOCKER to 35,000 sq ft of new concrete for our shop expansion. When done, they additionally burnished the surface to bring out more shine.

Tom Hennessy presented this system as providing a very high shine and a completely "sealed" floor surface which would be cost effective, tough, dust proof, easy to keep clean, and attractive. Now, six months later, we have a tough, dustproof, easy to keep clean and attractive concrete floor surface. The TOP BLOCKER sealed the DIAMOND HARD against stains, grease and oil so the surface looks virtually as it did when it was originally installed in spite of the area being a very active machining and metal fabrication shop.

Along with the DIAMOND HARD/FLORIDYNE application they also filled the concrete joints with their polyurea, PFAC, to keep the joints from filling with dirt and preventing their edges from breaking in use.

We have gotten many compliments on the neatness and attractiveness of our new shop and the floor is a big part of that. The DIAMOND HARD/FLORIDYNE SYSTEM has performed as presented. It is attractive, oil and other stains clean up easily and it shows very little wear even now after heavy use. The joints look the same as the day they were filled with the PFAC and are unbroken and easily cleaned. Later we had C.D. Products Inc fill the joints in our existing shop and by this simple action we have greatly improved our ability to clean and keep clean this shop area.

We recommend this system to anyone who wants a VERY attractive, high shine floor surface which is also tough, oil and stain resistant, and easily cleaned. Filling the joints was also a very good idea.
