PRODUCT BULLETIN SURFPREP 103

Description

SURFPREP 103 IS A SOLVENT BASED, REACTIVE SURFACE PREPARATION AND TACK WIPING AGENT DEVELOPED TO GET A CHEMICAL BOND BETWEEN EPOXY COATINGS AND EPOXY TO STEEL SUBSTRATES. THE SOLVENT IS ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL SO WHILE THERE IS A SLIGHT ODOR IT IS USUALLY NOT OBJECTIONABLE.

USES

SURFPREP 103 IS NECESSARY FOR BONDING BETWEEN EPOXY AND VARIOUS DIFFICULT TO ATTACH TO UNKNOWN EPOXIES AND TO STEEL.

APPLICATION

THE SURFACE TO BE COATED SHOULD BE THOROUGHLY CLEANED OF ANY RUST OR CONTAMINATION AND DEGREASED PRIOR TO WIPING. A SOLVENT WIPE AS THE LAST STEP IS ALSO SUGGESTED. SURFPREP 103 SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED A CLEANING SOLUTION. FOR IMPROVED ADHESION THE SURFACE SHOULD BE LIGHTLY SANDED OR MECHANICALLY ABRADED. DAMPEN A CLEAN RAG WITH SURFPREP 103 AND WIPE THE SURFACE. USE A LIGHT APPLICATION AT 500-600 SQFT/GAL. BE CAREFUL TO WIPE ALL AREAS. EXCESSIVE BONDING AGENTS WILL ACTUALLY CAUSE DEBONDING AND MISSED SPOTS MAY NOT BOND WITH THE SUBSEQUENT COATING AND PEEL OFF. RECOATING SHOULD BEGIN AS SOON AS THE SURFPREP 103 HAS EVAPORATED. FOR OTHER METALS THE USER IS ENCOURAGED TO TRY THE SURFPREP 103 BEFOR EXTENSIVE USAGE.

CAUTION

SURFPREP 103 CONTAINS ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL WHICH IS A FLAMMABLE SOLVENT SO CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO EXTINGUISH ALL FLAMES OR SOURCES OF COMBUSTION NEAR THE WORK WHILE USING THE PRODUCT.
